I think back to January 2020 and what I had hoped for and expected to happen that year. It feels so foreign, almost as if it was 12 years ago, not 12 months. In every way, our expectations have been smashed. Brian and I scrambled to jump through the hoops to get federal aid while also trying to meet the needs of churches who needed to quickly pivot their way of producing a weekly worship gathering to keep their communities connected. Although we weren't able to secure any PPP funding, we were protected against the devastating losses felt by many other ministries this year.



Our total giving and giving fell by 12% from 2019 and our overall revenue was down 17%, but this hit was out-weighted by the many unexpected ways TCA grew this year!

We almost doubled the number of churches and ministries we supported! Brian Davis successfully launched the Chasing Sunday Podcast and brought on our first long term coaching client! We partnered with Podcaster Loren Richmond Jr. to produce the 3rd season of the "Future Christian" podcast, building momentum with almost 1,000 downloads! Along with this, our team is getting stronger! Six worship leaders other than Brian and I have led worship on behalf of TCA in churches in Denver, and we've added three stakeholders to our regular team of creators!

We wouldn't have been able to do any of this work without your prayer and support! We are overwhelmed with gratitude for you. Thank you for believing in the creative leaders of the local church!
